

## **DIMENSIONAL APPLIQUE TECHNIQUES**

Background fabric 16" square muslin or any light background fabric 100% cotton-washed and presed.

Precut before class 2 bias strips of green for stems-one-3/4"x14" and one-3/4x10"

Scraps of variety of greens for leaves

Precut 1 strip 45" x 1 1/4" wide red, pink or what ever color for flower

Fat yarn – such as gift tie yarn 1/2 yd (I will furnish)

Needle with a large eye and blunt end or a trapunto needle

Blue marking pen

Applique Needles – size 9 or 10 sharps, plus a longer needle for ruching

Matching thread for stems, leaves, and flower (this can be #100 silk, Mettler #60, Aurifil, or any thinner thread. You will also need some stronger thread such as quilting thread for the ruching

6" or 12" ruler

Scissors, thimble, pencil and regular sewing supplies
